After a brief internship with the Department of Energy (DOE)'s Office of the Assistant General Counsel for the Environment (GC-51), Ms. Bogart began working for DOE at the Ohio Field Office, Fernald Environmental Management Project, practicing mostly in the fields of environmental law and contract administration.

From July 1999 through August 2003, Ms. Bogart served as a general attorney in the DOE/National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA)'s Albuquerque Operations Office, where she led the Operations Office's government ethics program. Ms. Bogart also performed as agency counsel in Administrative Review (personnel security), Federal Tort Claims Act, and Equal Employment Opportunity Commission cases. In addition, Ms. Bogart provided legal support on issues regarding public contract acquisitions, appropriations law, environmental law, transportation, security and national defense.

Since September 2003, Ms. Bogart has served as Site Office Counsel with the DOE/NNSA's Kansas City Site Office, where she provides legal support on issues concerning questions of law and administrative policy raised by the operation of an NNSA manufacturing facility.
