In addition, Mr. Martin has administrative responsibility for monitoring and assessing contractor financial performance.

Prior to his current position, Mr. Martin was the Deputy Division Chief in Resource Management for the International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Bureau of the U. S. Department of State. There he directed post-award contract administration, property management, financial analysis and budgeting for complex international programs in excess of \$2 billion.

Mr. Martin has more than 25 years of experience in accounting, budgeting and financial management. The majority of his career has been with the U. S. Department of Defense, but he has also had positions within the private sector. Past positions include CFO, Budget Officer, and Chief, Accounting & Inventory Control. Some notable assignments include leadership positions in the austere environments of Iraq and Afghanistan.
